We strive to protect the First Amendment rights of our patrons, and their individual rights of privacy. However, because Internet workstations are located in public areas, images on the screen and paper printouts of those images may be visible to others. Internet users must respect the rights and sensitivities of others, which is consistent with the library's general rules of conduct.

Use of the Library computer resources for any of the following is prohibited:

- Stealing, damaging or alter software or hardware
- Attempting to gain or gaining unauthorized access to files, passwords or data.
- Use for any purposes violating applicable federal, state or local laws
- Interfering with or disrupting other computer users
- Malicious, threatening, harassing or obscene behavior
- Public display of obscene materials on computer screen or in hard copy

Failure to use Internet workstations appropriately and responsibly may result in denial of further internet use privileges.
